Tether Assembly

1. Take the Mounting Flange and Center Rod Assembly (316 & 315) and insert into the center of the Pipe (314).

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- 2. Place Cushion Washer (312) into the Base Adapter (348).
- Place the Base Adapter into the Base (309) recess. 3.
- Line up dimples in the Pipe (314) and Tulip (313) so the Pipe will slide into the Tulip. 4
- 5. Line up outward notches on Tulip (313) with the notches on the Base (309) recess, while confirming the mounting flange is facing head on to ensure the machine will face forward.
- 6. Slide entire assembly into the Base (309).
- 7. Place Nut (310) on the Center Rod (315) under the Base and tighten.
- 8. Once the Nut (310) is tight, stand on the Base (309) and rock the Center Pipe (314) back and forth, then re-tighten the Nut (310). This helps ensure the Pipe will not loosen over time.
- NOTE: There will always be a small amount of sway. This helps to absorb shock, preventing the stand from breaking if mishandled.



- 2. Place Cushion Washer (312) into the Base Adapter (348).

Tether Assembly

- 3. Place the Base Adapter into the Base (309) recess.
- 4. Line up dimples in the Pipe (314) and Tulip (313) so the Pipe will slide into the Tulip.
- Line up outward notches on Tulip (313) with the notches on the Base (309) recess, 5. while confirming the Mounting Flange is facing head on to ensure the machine will face forward.
- 6. Slide entire assembly into the Base (309).
- 7. Place Nut (310) on the Center Rod (315) under the Base and tighten.

REQUIRED TOOLS (NOT SUPPLIED): 3/4" WRENCH OR SOCKET AND 7/16" SOCKET

1. Take the Mounting Flange and Center Rod Assembly (316 & 315) and insert into the center of the Pipe (314).

Place Cushion Washer (312) into the Base Adapter (348).

Place the Base Adapter into the Base (309) recess.

Line up dimples in the Pipe (314) and Tulip (313) so the Pipe will slide into the Tulip. 5. Line up outward notches on Tulip (313) with the notches on the Base (309) recess, while confirming the Mounting Flange is at a 45° angle to ensure the machine will face forward one mounted.

Slide entire assembly into the Base (309).

7. Place Nut (310) on the Center Rod (315) under the Base and tighten.

Once the Nut (310) is tight, stand on the Base (309) and rock the Center Pipe (314) back and forth, then re-tighten the Nut (310). This helps ensure the Pipe will not loosen over time. NOTE: There will always be a small amount of sway. This helps to absorb shock, preventing the stand from breaking if mishandled.

9. Place the Triple Bar (308) on top of the Flange (316) at a 45° angle to the Flange (parallel to the Base), matching to the holes of the Triple Bar. Insert the four 3/4" Carriage Bolts (387) from the bottom of the Flange (316), and use the four 1/4 x 20 nuts to secure the bar to the Flange. NOTE: If the Flange is not on a 45° angle, the machines will be on a angle to the stand Base (309).
